# MARINE CORPS HISTORY FOR JANUARY

## Submitted by Dave Twining

- **3 January 1945 -** VMF-213 and VMF-124, from the aircraft carrier U.S.S. Essex struck Formosa and the Ryukyu Islands, in the first Marine land strike from a carrier.
- **6 January 1859 -** Brig. Gen. Archibald Henderson died in office, having served 39 years as the 5<sup>th</sup> Commandant of the Marine Corps.
- 15 January 1943 Capt. Joe Foss downed three Japanese planes, bringing his total to a record 26 kills.
- 18 January 1961 Sgt. Major Bertha Peters was the first woman Sgt. Major in the Marine Corps.
- 24 January 1968 The 26th Marine Regiment held the Khe Sanh' Combat Base, Vietnam.
- 28 January 1942 The 4th Marine Regiment was assigned to support the Philippine Scouts on Bataan.
- 29 January 1991 Marines participated in the first major ground offensive of Operation Desert Storm.
- **31 January 1944 -** The American Flag was first raised on Japanese soil by B Co. 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 25<sup>th</sup> Marine Regiment, in the Marshall Islands.
